The proposed Visitor Centre will be created by re-purposing a line of listed properties facing Angel Hill, which are part of the Cathedral precinct and between the Abbey Gate and Norman Tower.

The Visitor Centre will welcome people to the site providing information, toilets, and a shop. There will be space to host school

groups and a room available for community use (such as workshops, classes or meetings). New interpretation spaces will explore the stories of the Abbey and St Edmund in new and exciting ways.

Visitors will be able to access the Visitor Centre from both Angel Hill and the Cathedral.
